
With reference to my visit to your plant and subsequent visit to two restaurants where Humicon Units are now in operation, I wish to report the following observations:

1. The William-Steiger Occupational Safety & Health Act, known as OSHA, does not recommend or disapprove products.
2. At a meeting with Mr. Jack McKichan, Industrial Hygienist for the South Florida OSHA Area Director's Office, the clay product of the Allophene group which is the heart of the Humicon Unit was noted as being non-toxic, and therefore not in violation of any OSHA Health Standards.
3. At the same meeting, Mr. Ray Harvey, OSHA Senior Compliance Officer for this area observed the construction of the Humicon Unit and could find no violation of the OSHA Safety Standards..

In view of the fact that Humicon Units have no moving parts, exude no fumes, are light weight and properly installed where employees will not bump their heads on them, we have no recourse but to state that Humicon Unit poses no safety or health hazards, and this opinion is reflected also by the aforementioned OSHA officials.

We are impressed with the high quality and potential of this unit in improving our way of life and wish you well.
